Medication Instructions for Diabetics

*If you are taking any of the following diabetic pills (hypoglycemic medications):

Amaryl, Chlorpropamide Diabetea, Diabinese, Glipizide, Glucotrol, Glucovance, Glyburide, Glynase, Metaglip, Micronase, Tolbutamide, Tolazamide, Prandin, Starlix

The day before procedure: Take your usual dose (if possible)

On the day of procedure: **Do not take the medication before the test,**

Take your usual dose after the exam.

*If you are taking any the following diabetic pills (non-hypoglycemic medications)

Actos, Avandamet, Avandia, Glucophage, Metformin

No Changes; continue with usual dose the day before and day of the exam.

*If you are on Insulin:

-And using: Humalog, Novolog, Regular insulin

Adjust according to finger-stick results and calories.

-And using: Humalog 5/25, Humulin 70/30, Lente, Novolog 70/30, NPH, Ultra

Lente

Night before the preparation: Decrease evening dose by half of your usual dose.

On the day of Preparation: Decrease all doses by half of your usual dose

On the day of testing: **DO NOT TAKE ANY INSULIN**

-And using: Lantus, Levemir

Night before preparation: Decrease night dose by of half of usual

Preparation day: Decrease night doses by half of usual

The instructions above are only guidelines which may be altered
